




DIRECTIONS TO

From Disney & I-Drive

- Take route 528 (Beeline Expwy Toll) East towards Cocoa Beach.
- Take route 417 north (Greenway Toll) to exit 33-A which will put you east bound on route 408 (East-West Expwy Toll).
- Take the Alafaya Trail exit and turn right.
- Go 3.6 mi. to second Stoneybrook entrance on left.

From Downtown

- Take route 408 east (East-West Expwy Toll) towards Titusville.
 - Take the Alafaya Trail exit and turn right- heading south.
 - Go 3.6 mi. to second Stoneybrook entrance on left.

tournament.**



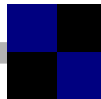
Orlando Minority Youth Golf Association
